Basics

These all use ChatGPT EDU; get an account if you don't have one.

All of these examples may need some tweaking for your uses.

Remember that working with AI is interactive and iterative.

Verify, verify, verify. [Human > AI > Human]

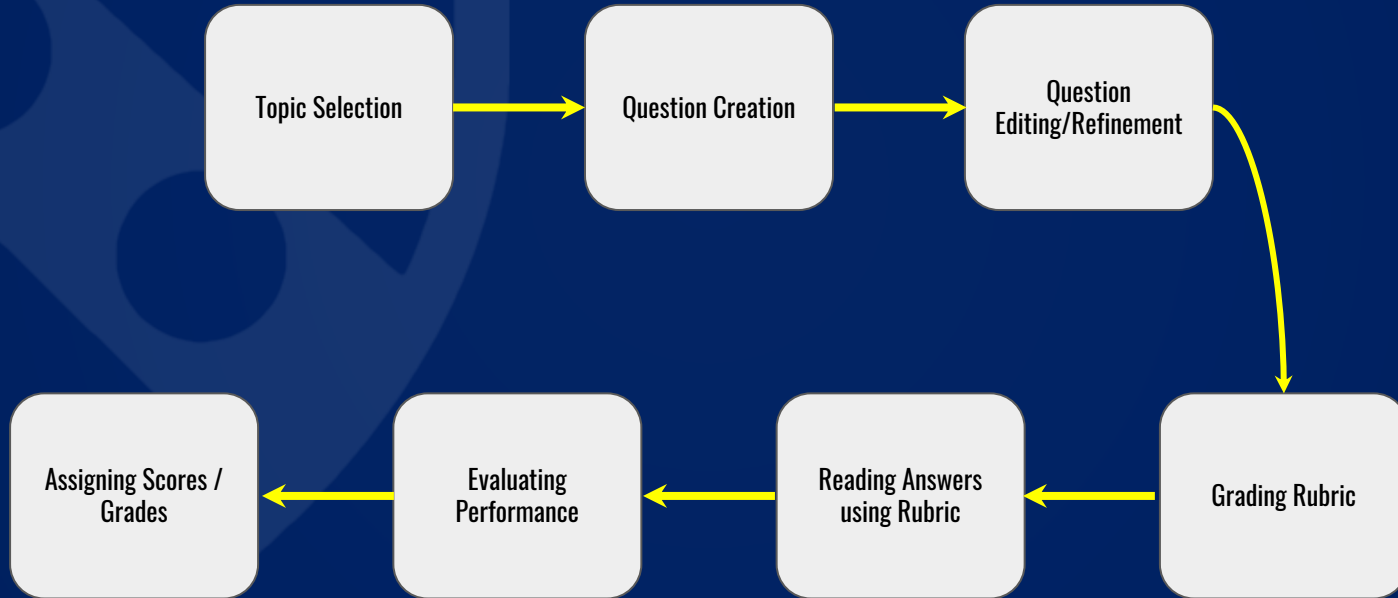

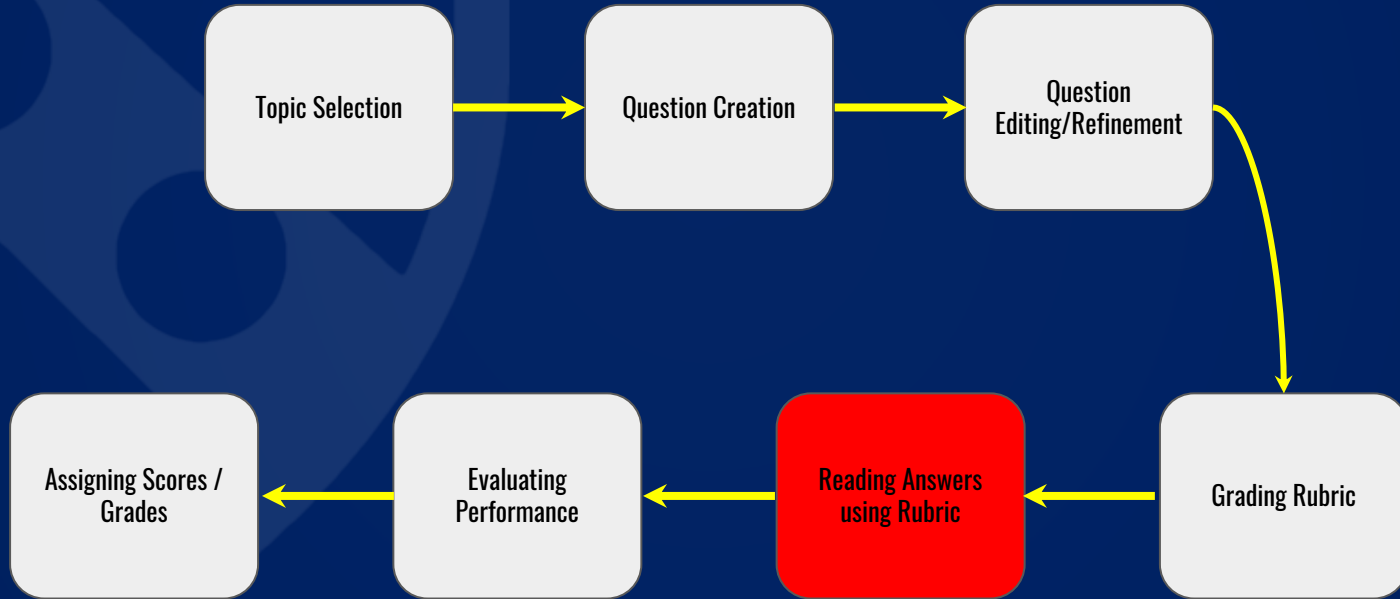
Some other AI uses for exams

- Give AI your question and ask it to answer it as a check on what you think is covered.
 - Note: the more contextual info you give it (readings, slides, etc) the better!
- Have the AI help you determine word count limits, time limits, etc.
- Have the AI help you create a grading rubric.
- Give the AI a grading rubric and the question and ask it to create a “perfect” answer.
- Give the AI your MC questions and ask it for suggestions etc.

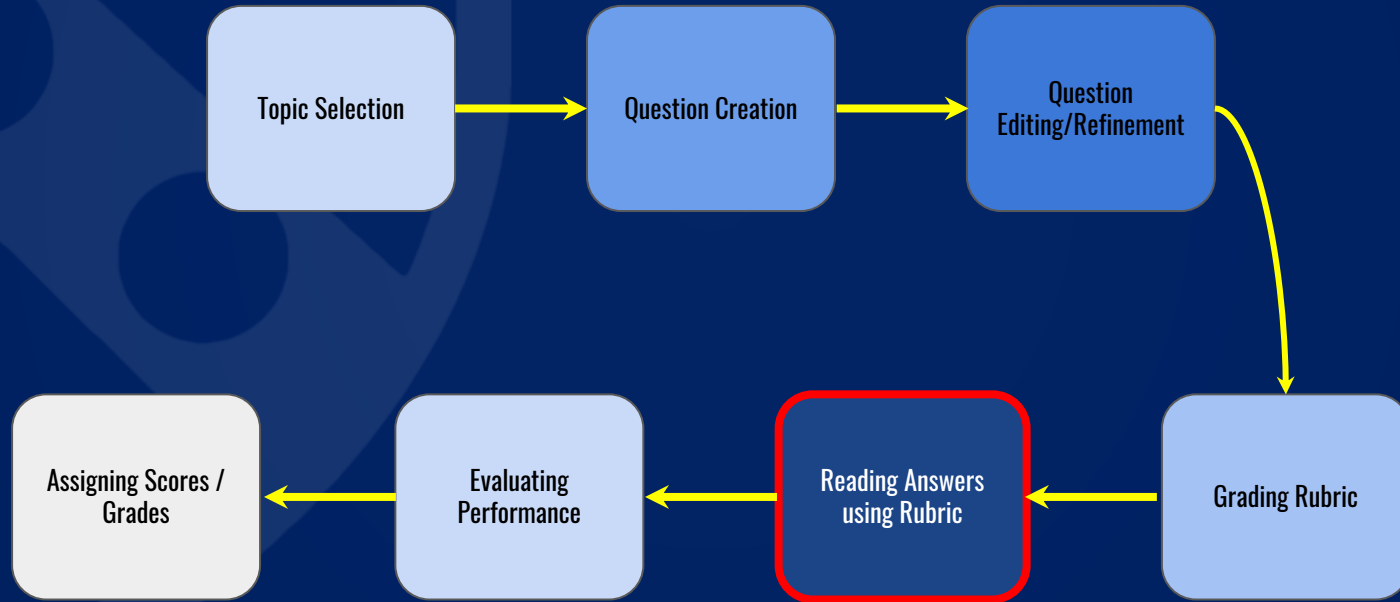
What's Ahead: A Typical Essay Exam Workflow
